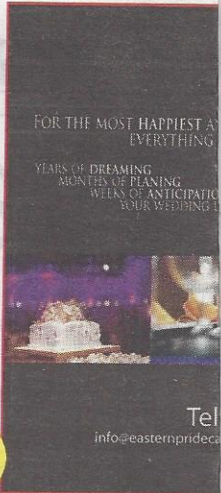

Rushanara Ali told this in meeting organised by UK Bangladesh Catalyst of Commerce and Industry in Central London on 25th May. UKBCCI organised this dinner party to celebrate the recent appoint of Rushanara Ali as the Trade Envoy of Bangladesh. Barrister Anwar Babul Miah, Director of UKBCCI, conducted the meeting.

Rushanara Ali also mentioned that during the Labour Government's term, UK curry industry used to bring skilled labour from many countries including Bangladesh and India.
