Voice of Members:



I attended a 2 day investment summit on 28-29 November 2021 at the Radisson in Dhaka marking the Golden Jubilee of Bangladesh joined by our Chairman Mr Iqbal Ahmed OBE, President Mr Nazmul Nuru and Former (Founding) President Mr Bajloor Rashid MBE. The Summit was formally inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina and guests attended from all over the world with the event being taglined: "Limitless Opportunities" prevailing in "Sonar Bangla" Bangladesh today.

Bangladesh inspires to become an upper middle income country by 2031 and a developed country by 2041. With a rising per capita income of \$2,500, the purchase capacity of people has increased significantly in a country with an enormous domestic market consisting of 170 million people. This suggests a significant opportunity for us NRB's to invest in Bangladesh during this window. At the Birth of Bangladesh in 1971, the country had a GDP of \$8.8 billion. Today, Bangladesh's GDP has grown 46 times to \$410 billion with the foreign exchange reserve at \$46.5 billion. The average life expectancy has increased from 46 years to 72 years and in terms of women empowerment, Bangladesh is positioned first in South Asia and ahead of USA globally according to the World Economic Forum.

Bangladesh is establishing 100 economic zones across the country which are investor friendly with a range of incentives & tax benefits and has significant cost advantages in respect of labour and utilities compared to neighbouring counties in the region.

Mr Iqbal Ahmed OBE was a panel speaker at the Summit and gave a very inspiring speech to investors in the Agribusiness sector and said that "Agriculture is the future business of Bangladesh" referring to food exports in particular and echoing what the Hon'ble Prime Minister said at the Investment Summit in London on 4th November 2021. At the end of the second day of the Summit, Bangladesh received a whopping \$2.7 billion worth of investment proposals, half of which came from the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia investing in the Power and Energy sector. There are of course ample of opportunities for NRB's to invest in Bangladesh. In total there are 11 sectors the government is putting forward for investment in particular these include blue economy, healthcare and pharmaceuticals, transport and logistics, capital market, power and energy, the fourth industrial revolution, financial services, agribusiness, leather and leather goods, apparel, electrical and electronics manufacturing.

The UKBCCI has close ties with BIDA and other government agencies in Bangladesh. Over the last couple of years, I have engaged directly with BIDA, The British High Commission and Government Ministries. I encourage members who wish to invest in Bangladesh to engage and utilise the expertise of these organisations who can provide invaluable advice and guidance which can be hugely useful if you are thinking of setting up a business in Bangladesh.


